This system covers measures 66 to 69. The Violin I part (VI.) begins at measure 66 with a sixteenth-note scale: G4, A4, Bb4, C5, D5, Eb5, F5, G5. It then has rests for two measures before re-entering at measure 69 with a half-note chord: G4, Bb4, D5. The Piano part (Pno.) starts at measure 66 with a half-note chord: G4, Bb4, D5. It features a forte (*f*) dynamic and includes two fermatas over the first and second measures of the system.

It has a half-note rest in measure 75 and a half-note chord: G4, Bb4, D5 in measure 76.
